

Here are our Top 5 FAQs to assist you while we are out for the holidays.

1 How can I attest to my quality improvement (QI) activities?

Log in to ABA Go, click on the QI tab of your dashboard and click the blue "Attest" button. Click the box beside "I attest that I have completed 25 points of ABA-approved QI activities" and click the Submit button. QI activities are subject to audit, so keep documentation of your completed activities.

2 How do I submit my CMEs?

You can self-report your CME activities, including activities you completed in previous years, in [ABA Go](#). Log in, click on your CME tab and click "Report New CME." You can also download our [instructional PDF](#). If you are participating in CME for MOCA Minute questions, your credits earned from the ASA will be reported to us in late January 2023.

3 My certification expires this year, and I've completed the MOCA components. What happens next?

When the top portion of your Progress Report in [ABA Go](#) shows "Approved for Certification" in green (click on MOCA in the navigation, and then click on My Progress Report), you've completed everything. In late December, we will post a congratulatory letter in ABA Go, and our [directory](#) will show your new certificate issue date.

4 I've answered all my MOCA Minute questions, my performance is below the $\geq .10$ standard, and my certification expires this year. What can I do?

In January, we'll move your 10-year MOCA 2.0 cycle forward one year, so you'll have until Dec. 31, 2023, to complete all components. Any CME credits you completed in the first year of your original cycle will be removed. Once you complete all components, we'll send you a new certificate.

In 2023, you'll have two options for completing the assessment component:

- **OPTION 1: Continue participating in MOCA Minute** to increase your performance standard by the end of 2023. Use your Knowledge Assessment Report and Question History in your portal to identify areas of focus.
- **OPTION 2: Take and pass the Anesthesiology Special Purpose Exam** in lieu of participating in MOCA Minute. You can take it once for free if you register by June 30.

5 What happens if I don't answer all my MOCA Minute questions by 11:59 p.m. EST Dec. 31?

You can answer as many as 30 questions per day. Any unanswered questions will be counted as incorrect, which will lower your MOCA Minute performance value. If your value is $\geq .10$, you're meeting the performance standard. You can see how you're doing on the MOCA Minute tab of your dashboard in [ABA Go](#).
