

Patient Safety CME

Revised: Oct. 2024

As part of a board-certified anesthesiologist's CME continuing certification requirements, clinicians must complete a number of patient safety credits. Every five years, 10 ABA-approved patient safety credits must be completed. For anesthesiologists on a 10-year certification cycle, they must complete a total of 20 credits by the end of year 10. Please follow the below instructions to access ABA-approved patient safety courses through each site.

CME Passport

b. "Free" or "Variable" under "Fee"


