

CANDIDATE APPLIED EXAM COVID-19 SAFETY GUIDELINES

The following guidelines keep all candidates, examiners and staff safe and healthy throughout the exam experience.



Vaccination Card

You must provide either a COVID-19 **vaccination record card** from the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC) or **proof of vaccination** from your healthcare provider **14 days before your scheduled exam week**. In addition, a **signed attestation to the authenticity** of the COVID-19 vaccination record is required.



Signed Attestation

You must sign an attestation stating you have been COVID-19 **symptom-free for three days** before arriving in Raleigh.



Mask Policy

Masks are required, but can be removed temporarily while eating or drinking.



Shaking Hands

Please **refrain** from shaking hands.

ADDITIONAL PROTOCOLS



PRIOR TO ARRIVING IN RALEIGH

Candidates with a **positive COVID-19 test result** within three days of their scheduled exam should notify **the ABA immediately** at APPLIEDexam@theABA.org.

Do NOT travel to Raleigh. Staff will work with candidates to cancel their current exam appointment and reschedule for a future date.

AFTER ARRIVING IN RALEIGH

Candidates **who test positive after arriving in Raleigh** will be asked to return to their hotel room and follow current CDC quarantine guidelines until they can arrange to return home safely.
