

Examiner APPLIED Exam COVID-19 Safety Guidelines

The following guidelines keep all candidates, examiners and staff safe and healthy throughout the exam experience.



Vaccination Card

You are asked to digitally upload either a COVID-19 vaccination record card from the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC) or proof that you are fully vaccinated, including a booster, from your healthcare provider 14 days before your scheduled exam week.



Signed Attestation You must sign a daily attestation at the AIME Center stating you have been COVID-19 symptom-free for three days.



Mask Policy

Masks are required in exam areas at the AIME Center and are optional in Town Hall or while eating and drinking.

Physical Distancing

Practice physical distancing as much as possible during lunch in the examiner

lounges when you cannot wear a mask.



Additional Protocols



PRIOR TO ARRIVING IN RALEIGH

Examiners with a **positive COVID-19 test result** within three days of their scheduled arrival in Raleigh should notify the ABA immediately at APPLIEDexam@theaba.org. **Do NOT travel to Raleigh.** Staff will remove the examiner from their assignments.

AFTER ARRIVING IN RALEIGH

Examiners who **test positive after arriving in Raleigh** will be asked to return to their hotel room and follow current CDC quarantine guidelines until they can arrange to return home safely.
