

The following report describes concepts from the 2024 In-Training Examination that were most misunderstood by examinees. This document is intended to assist and support you in the design of your educational program.

- In infants the anteromedial proximal tibia is the preferred site for an intraosseous cannula placement.
- Amiodarone potentiates the effect of direct oral anticoagulants.
- Urinary symptoms are common findings in chronic adhesive arachnoiditis.
- For procedures under deep sedation, aspiration is less common than complications from the procedures themselves.
- Black children are more likely to suffer respiratory compromise than White children.
- The chloride channel is abnormal in patients with myotonia congenita.
- Cystatin C is an accurate biomarker of renal function.
- The terminal half-life is the smallest exponent on a semilogarithmic graph.
