

Candidate APPLIED Exam COVID-19 Safety Guidelines

The following guidelines keep all candidates, examiners and staff safe and healthy throughout the exam experience.



Vaccination Card

You are asked to digitally upload either a COVID-19 vaccination record card from the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC) or proof that you are fully vaccinated, including a booster, from your healthcare provider 14 days before your scheduled exam week. Failure to upload proof of vaccination will result in cancellation of your examination.



Signed Attestation

You must sign an attestation on your examination day stating you have been COVID-19 **symptom-free for three days** before arriving in Raleigh.



Mask Policy

Masks are required, but can be removed temporarily while eating or drinking.



Additional Protocols

PRIOR TO ARRIVING IN RALEIGH

Candidates with a **positive COVID-19 test result** within three days of their scheduled exam **should notify the ABA immediately** at APPLIEDexam@theaba.org. **Do NOT travel to Raleigh.** Staff will work with candidates to cancel their current exam appointment and reschedule for a future date.

AFTER ARRIVING IN RALEIGH

Candidates who **test positive after arriving in Raleigh** will be asked to return to their hotel room and follow current CDC quarantine guidelines until they can arrange to return home safely.
